

Pavement and Bridge Rehabilitation on I-690 in the Towns of Geddes, Van Buren, Lysander and the Village of Baldwinsville, New York



General Project Description:

This NYSDOT project included fourteen miles of resurfacing and three bridge rehabilitations on I-690 and NY 690. The pavement restoration portion of the project included removing the top 1.5 inches of asphalt and resurfacing, as well as performing full depth repairs where needed. The project began on I-690 in Syracuse at Hiawatha Boulevard and continued westerly to Exit 1 of the NYS Thruway. Paving work will continue onto NY 690 to the intersection of Hencle Boulevard and Route 48 in Lysander. In 2014, the project will continue with the rehabilitation of the bridges carrying NY 690 over Downer Street, the Seneca River and Route 370. Ravi Engineering & Land Surveying, P.C. provided survey stakeout services to the contractor on this project.
