



PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Canal Side is a new mixed-use neighborhood that reconnects Downtown Buffalo to the Lake Erie waterfront through a network of streets, canals, and public spaces. With approximately 1.1 million square feet of development, including retail, restaurant, hotel, office, cultural, and residential uses, Canal Side is made up of 23 development parcels within approximately 20 acres on the Buffalo Riverfront. The project includes restaurants, entertainment venues, retail outlets, cultural attractions, public spaces, and increased access to the Buffalo River.

RE&LS provided Construction Inspection for this project includes major public infrastructure improvements, including: public canals, towpaths, lighting, canopies, signage, canal bridge spans, replica packet boats and barges, improved streetscapes, floating docks, public parking options, the Prime Slip, Canal Side Hall, the Gateway Building, the Atrium Building, design costs, contingencies, and other canal district/inner harbor improvements.
