



## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The \$6.75 million Humphrey Nature Center in Letchworth State Park is a 5,000-square-foot educational facility focusing on sustainability and environmental education, includes meeting space, classrooms, a butterfly garden and interactive exhibits that promote activity within the park. Programs, including interactive activities and exhibits, will also be offered here for park visitors.

The nature center, complete with solar panels on the roof, located near the Trailside Lodge and tubing hill, is near the historic Glen Iris Inn and Inspiration Point. It is about two miles from the Castile, Wyoming County, entrance, and will remain open year-round.

RE&LS provided survey and mapping for the NYSOPRHP Letchworth Park Nature Center. The project includes design of an approximate 7,000-8,000 sf building, site improvements, pathways, access road and utility service connections. We established baseline control and survey in the nature center area, pathways and contiguous areas and prepared base map drawings in AutoCad.

Ravi also performed a topographic survey of the parking lot and utility corridors for utilities to connect to the existing electrical transformer near the existing warming hut, as well as the water line along the park access road and the septic treatment facility
