



## PROJECT DISCIPTION

Ravi Engineering & Land Surveying, P.C. provided survey stakeout services for the construction of a structure at the Wild Center Natural History Museum. The Wild Walk is a permanent structure that includes a network of bridges and raised platforms. It is more than 1000 feet in total length, with approximately 850 of those feet above the ground. The trail has many detours so that people can take different paths and have different experiences.

The upper section of walk has culminated in a single raised platform soaring above the ground and offering an unbroken view of the Adirondack forest. RE&LS completed plan review, location of existing field control and control adjustment. We also set additional project benchmarks and horizontal control and performed layout of working points for the center of each raised platform. The as-built location of each pier foundation was then completed.
